2/11/2017 Minutes:

The Meeting was held at Marie Callendars Restaurant in Corona, and called to order by President Mitsy Marquez, @10:10 am. Members present were: Linda Dunn, Gail Courtney, Sandy Grimes, Jeanine Blanchard, Rene Sharp, Jack Morck, Mitsy Marquez and Katie Watts. Rene made the motion to accept the minutes, Jeannine 2nd the minutes were accepted.

Treasurers Report: Rene presented the report. Insurance payment is pending for 7 events all other bills are paid. Income from the Banquet was discussed. Jeannine made the motion to accept the report, Linda 2nd and the treasurer's report was accepted.

Committee Reports:

Hospitality: Liz will follow-up on the arrangements. The trail ride is on the MFTHBA website. Rene will send get well cards to Susan and Sally.

Bill is not available in June to present Cowboy dressage at our clinic. But she has been investigating Horsetalk, and high desert sources as well as Cowboy dressage and obstacle challenge at Pepper Glenn Ranch. Rene will contact Pepper Glenn about a possible introduction to Cowboy dressage or obstacles at our clinic.

Clinic: Rene stated that after the next meeting Missouri is going to send a clinician list or recommendation pending clinic approval by Missouri.

The Board discussed the Class schedule and decided to Swap 2 morning classes but otherwise to retain the 2016 schedule.

Show News

Wow here it is March and the start of CFTA's 2017 show season is just around the corner with our first of five shows on Saturday April 22nd. This show as well as our show June 24th, our Clinic on June 25th and our show on July 29th, will all be in Norco at *PepperGlen Farm*. CFTA's show May 20th and our Championship show on Oct 7th will both be back at **Ridge Riders** Arena in West Covina.

PepperGlen Farm Particulars

There is a mandatory grounds fee of \$15 per horse for all participants. Directions: From the 15 freeway Exit at 6th Street and head east to California Ave, where you will turn right. Access to the grounds is thru the back gate off of California Ave, look for a green sign for *PepperGlen Farm* on your right. Travel down the narrow dirt road to the trailer parking area which is marked off with white chalk. Rigs must park within this area so that emergency vehicles can pass and make the circuit around the parked rigs. Cars are to park on the right before the trailer parking area and we have been asked to pull in towards the fence.

There are several advantages to showing at *PepperGlen* with one of the most important being the availability of stalls. We have the choice of either day stalls for \$10 per horse or mare motel stalls for \$15 per horse. The day stalls are approximately 12X12 uncovered pipe corral stalls. The mare motel stalls are approximately 12X24, covered, have welded wire on all sides, plus a tack locker included, one just needs to bring your own lock for the locker. If you want stalls or plan to arrive the day before the show, please contact Sandy Grimes 909-744-0151 or sandyroy00@hotmail.com so I can let the grounds know how many stalls are needed. Dry camping is also available and free for competitors wishing to stay overnight on the grounds. We also have the use of a round pen, a small arena where the trail course will be set up, a wash rack and an open area that could be used as a warmup space.

Another plus is that there are nice restrooms and a shower.

We are looking forward to this new venue and all the extras it has to offer. Since there are not any bleachers, you will need to bring your own chairs if you would like to sit in the grassy viewing area between the trailer parking area and the show arena.

THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES ALLOWED ON THE GRASSY VIEWING AREA

More News

Missouri is doing away with the National High Point Program as we have known it for years and replacing it with a Buckle Series. More information will follow when the program is approved, but competitors will need to be both CFTA and MFTHBA members in order to be eligible, so make sure your memberships for both are current. CFTA will continue to offer year end high point awards for all of our classes, plus the coveted Overall High Point Award. Just remember you need to compete in at least three shows to be eligible for CFTA awards. We will continue to allow horses of any breed to compete in fifteen of our classes. Classes that are open to just registered fox trotters are: the 3 model classes, open fox trot - ladies, amateur fox trot - 4 years and older, youth fox trot - 17 and under, open fox trot - gentlemen, open fox trot - 4 years and older, open fox trot - 2 years and older, and open fox trot - 4 years and older will canter.

Curly horses were first observed among wild mustangs in the western U.S. and are still found among wild herds to this day. The dominant curly gene in Missouri Fox Trotters traces back to a gaited curly stallion of unknown ancestry named Curly Jim. Some of his gaited, curly daughters were bred to fox trotting stallions and their offspring were registered in MFTHBA when it was an open registry. Some Curlies are hypoallergenic for people allergic to straight-haired horses.
